Oak Street Fingerless Gloves

Named after the main street in Yvonne's home town of Hood River, Oregon, these gloves keep your hands warm but fingertips free, allowing you to knit, work a camera, or perform any activity requiring a precision touch.

materials

- fingering-weight yarn, approx 200 yds

- set of 5 size 2 (2.75mm) double-pointed needles and/or set of two size 2 (2.75mm) circular needles or size to obtain gauge
- yarn needle
- stitch marker

Samples use Mountain Colors Bearfoot in Copper (man's glove) and Crystal Palace Panda Wool in #xxxx.

gauge

28 sts/46 rnds = 4" in st st

difficulty

advanced beginner

sizes

Sized for M/L (XL/XXL)
Hand Circumference: 7 (9)"

Note: The ribbed pattern is quite stretchy and each size will fit a wide range of hands.
