This scarf was knit from one precious skein of buffalo-down yarn and named for the Lakota holy woman also known as White Buffalo Woman. Just as Ptesan-Wi taught the Lakota people many skills they needed to survive, this scarf will improve your lace knitting with stunning results.

materials

- lace or fingering-weight yarn, at least 350 yds
- size 6 (4mm) needles or size to obtain gauge
- yarn needle
- cable needle
- stitch markers

Sample uses Buffalo Gold #11 2-ply Laceweight.

gauge

22 sts/32 rows = 4" in stockinette st (gauge is not critical for this project)
