Syncopated Rib Coat

This snugly knitted coat utilizes a unique pattern of ribbing that mimics the short-long-short pattern of a syncopated jazz beat. Knit seamlessly for minimal finishing. Pictured with approximately 5" of negative ease.

materials

- worsted-weight yarn, approx 1505 (1680, 1810, 2010, 2150) yds
- 36" size 8 (5mm) circular

needle or size to obtain gauge

- set of 5 size 8 (5mm) dpns or 12-16" size 8 (5mm) circular needle for sleeves
- size 6 (4mm) needles for button bands
- stitch holders
- yarn needle
- stitch markers
- (4) 1-1/2" round buttons
- sewing needle & thread

Sample uses Malabrigo Worsted in Red Mahogany.

gauge

16 sts/24 rows = 4" in st st
24 sts/24 rows = 4" in body rib
