## Underwater Basketweaving Socks

There has been a long-standing joke between my husband and I about me never knitting socks for him. My excuse is that his feet are too big. I came up with this pattern to address that problem - these socks knit up quickly with a fun, stretchy basketweave pattern that isn't too fiddly. Perfect for the big (and not-so-big) feet in your life!

### materials

- worsted-weight yarn, approx 300 yds
- set of 5 size 3 (3.25mm) double-pointed needles or set of 2 size 3 (3.25mm) 24" circular needles or size to obtain gauge
- yarn needle

Sample uses Artyarns Supermerino, color #136.

### gauge

24 sts/32 rows = 4" in st st

### difficulty

easy

### size

Women's M/Men's S

(Women's L/Men's M,  
Men's L)

Foot Circumference: 7.5  
(8, 8.5)"
