

## **Shape Right Front**

Place right front sts on ndl. Join yarn at neck edge with RS facing, BO 5 sts at neck edge, work to end in pats as estab. 26 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** Work even as estab.

**Row 2:** BO 5 sts at neck edge, work to end as estab. 21 sts.

**Row 3:** Work even as estab.

**Row 4:** K1, SSK, work to end as estab.

**Row 5:** Work even as estab.

**Rows 6-7:** Rep Rows 4-5. 19 sts.

**Row 8:** Work even as estab.

## **Shape Sleeve Cap**

BO 5 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, then BO 2 sts at beg of following 4 rows. 75 (75, 77, 79, 81) sts.

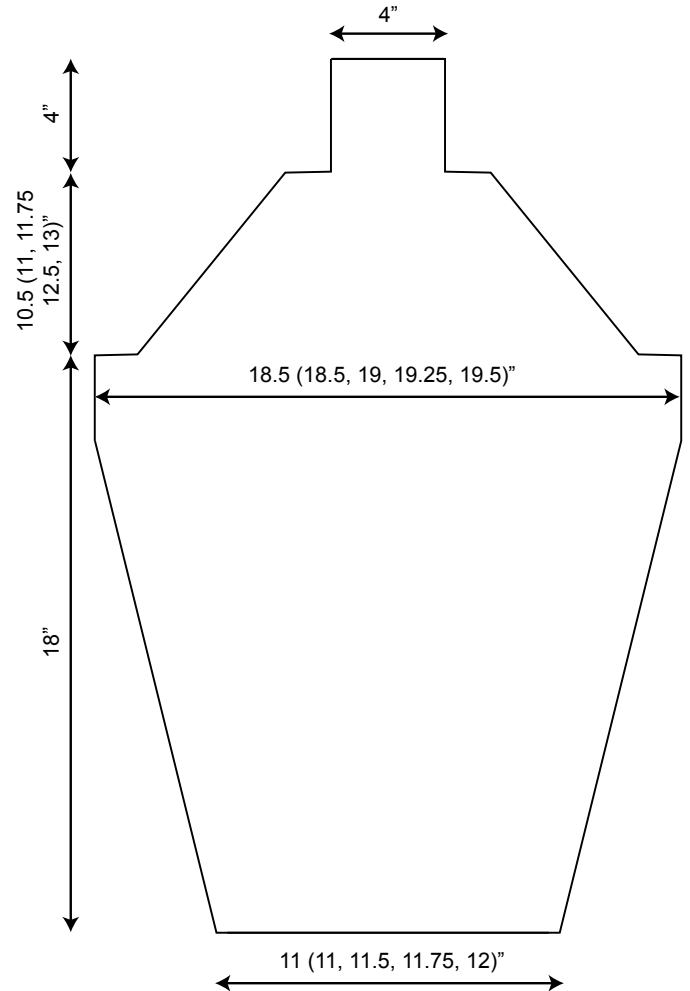
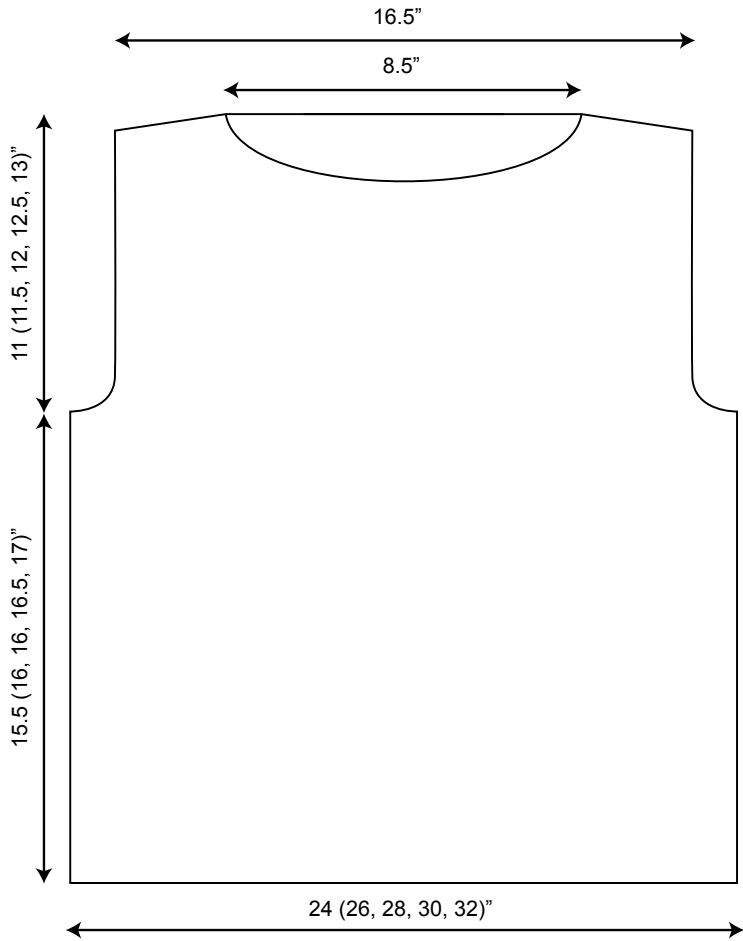
Dec 1 st at beg and end of next 9 (9, 9, 10, 10) RS rows as follows - K1, SSK, work as estab to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. 57 (57, 59, 59, 61) sts.

Work even in pat as estab for 3 (3.5, 4, 4.5, 4.5)". Dec 1 st at beg and end of next 9 (9, 10, 10, 11) RS rows. 39 sts.

Work next WS row even as estab.

BO 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows, then BO 5 sts at beg of following 2 rows. 21 sts.
